Special Instructions for registering online for Advanced Placement Courses and special classes:

1. If you meet the requirements for the course, sign up for the course under the name of the A.P., not the “__WAIV” designation. If you don’t know whether you meet the requirements for the course, try it this way first. Submit your request. If your request is rejected, an error message will pop up containing the Boolean code which explains why your request was rejected. For example, “ERROR – admission to SB3X based upon avg(“S”)>=91” means science average must be at least 91% and your average is lower. Log back in and register again, but this time choose the A.P. name with the “__WAIV” attached. Submit your request again. If it goes through, it means your request to be waitlisted for the course has been registered. If you receive the error message again, you must see the Department Chairperson.
2. If you want A.P. English – with the exception of American Studies (E55X) – you must choose E5X or E7X under AP1. Then, you must submit your request. The system will check to see if you meet the English grade requirement. Now, log back in and choose the A.P. you want under the E5 or E7 menu. If you only want one particular course, you need not give second or third choices. However, if you really want an English A.P., you should give choices.
3. If you want A.P. English American Studies, which is a linked English-U.S. History course (E55X-H55X), you must choose E5X under AP1 and H55X under AP2. Submit the request; log back in and choose E55X under the E5 menu.
4. If you want A.P. English Physics and Metaphysics (E59X or E79X) and you have not taken A.P. Physics before, you must sign up for A.P. Physics B as a corequisite. Choose E5X under AP1 and SP1X under AP2. Submit the request; log back in and choose E59X under the E5 menu or E79X under the E7 menu.
5. If you want A.P. Physics Level C (SP3X) and have not taken A.P. Calculus, you must sign up for A.P. Calculus BC (MC3X) as a corequisite. Choose MC3X under AP1. Submit the request; log back in and choose SP3X_MATH under AP2. If you want A.P. Physics Level C and have already taken A.P. Calculus AB, you must sign up for Multivariate Calculus (MC5) as a corequisite. Choose SP3X_MC5.
6. If you want A.P. Biology (SB3X) or A.P. Environmental (SE1X) and have not taken the prerequisite, you must sign up for SB3X_COREQ or SE1X_COREQ. In phase 2, you will choose your corequisite.
7. If you want A.P. European History (H3GX) or A.P. World History (H3WX) and are scheduled to take regular Global 2 (H3G), sign up for H3GX or HGWX.
8. If you want A.P. Computer Science (ML1X) and have not completed Intro to Computer Science (ML1), please speak with your Computer Science Teacher.
9. If you want Honors Chemistry and are scheduled to take Regents Chemistry (SC1) next year, sign up for SC1H under SC1. You will not see SC1H under the A.P. menu since it is not an A.P. course.
10. If you want to register for any of the Intel classes, you must see Dr. Gastel (science), Mr. Brooks (math) or Ms. Suri (social sciences).
11. If your overall average is not high enough to take an extra A.P., please see your Guidance Counselor for a Parental Waiver Form for Advanced Placement Courses. After the form has been signed by you, your parent, and guidance counselor and submitted to the Program Office, an extra A.P. menu will be given to you for you to choose online. This menu will be entitled “AP_Plus1.”
12. Choose the A.P.’s you want in the order of your preference. If there is a budget cut, the Program Office will know that the *last* numbered A.P. (e.g. AP4) is the one you *least* want.
13. Remember you are submitting requests. You will not know if you have been accepted into the courses until the Department Chairpersons have made selections based on department requirements and budgetary constraints. In Phase 2 of online programming when Chairpersons have completed selections, you will see the Advanced Placement and 10Tech and special classes in your request file.
